



GSA SCHEDULE 874V

LOGISTICS WORLDWIDE (LOGWORLD) SERVICES

SPECIAL ITEM NUMBERS (SINs): 874-501, 874-502, 874-503, and 874-504

The GSA LOGWORLD schedule, awarded to LOGTEC October 30, 2001 and extending through October 29, 2006, allows LOGTEC to provide worldwide logistics services and products to enable Government agencies to meet demands for supply and value chain management, transportation and distribution, and deployment logistic services. SINs describe the products and services that are solicited under this schedule. LOGTEC's SINs for GSA LOGWORLD are 874-501, 874-502, 874-503, and 874-504.

874-501: Supply and Value Chain Management - Services under this SIN include planning, developing, managing, operating, and maintaining logistics systems dealing with the acquisition support, movement, and maintenance of resources. LOGTEC may provide assistance and guidance in support of an agency's assessment of the best combination of channels to create value for its customers.

874-502: Acquisition Logistics - Services under this SIN involve the logistics management discipline which supports a product or system through its life cycle. Services may include acquisition logistics or integrated logistics support associated with the design, development, test, production, fielding, sustainment, and improvement of cost effective systems including the eventual disposal or salvage of these systems. LOGTEC may provide logistics expertise in the pre-production or design phase of systems to ensure that the system can be supported through its lifecycle and that the infrastructure elements necessary for operational support are identified and acquired. These services may continue through the life cycle of the system or product and include guidance, assistance and/or operational support.

874-503: Distribution and Transportation Logistics Services - Services under this SIN include moving and storage (excluding household goods), transportation system development and management, carrier management and routing, and freight forwarding. Services may include planning and design, implementation, or operation of systems or facilities for the movement of supplies, equipment or people by road, air, water, rail, or pipeline.

874-504: Deployment Logistics - Services under this SIN include contingency planning; inventory/property planning, movement, storage, and accountability; and communications and logistics systems to permit rapid deployment and management of supplies and equipment. Expert guidance or operational support to identify and utilize regional or global resources, and integrate public and private sector resources.
